

FILING YOUR 990EZ OR 990N E POSTCARD

990EZ or 990N EPostcard

Several of our Cabanes have lost their tax exempt status because they failed to file either the 990EZ or the 990N EPostcard for the past three years. Getting reinstated could be a costly and time consuming ordeal for these cabanes. Don't let this happen to you!!

Here's how to get to the 990N EPostcard:

You will need to provide:

1. [Employer identification number](#) (EIN), also known as a Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN)).
2. [Tax year](#) (we're doing 2010 tax year)
3. Legal name and mailing address
(La Societe de Femme and your Correspondante's address)
4. Any other names the organization uses
(Cabane Locale #) OR (Grande Cabane de ???)
5. Name and address of a principal officer (this is your Correspondante)
6. Web site address if the organization has one (www.fortyandeight.org)
7. Confirmation that the organization's annual [gross receipts](#) are [normally \\$25,000 or less](#) (\$50,000 for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2010)
8. If applicable, a statement that the organization has terminated or is terminating (going out of business)
