

Carville Star – Carol Kaiserian, Chairman

Let me introduce myself - I am Carol Kaiserian, a Dame since 1998 in Cabane 1219, Florida. and have served many Locale, Grande and Nationale positions. This year I am wearing a new Beret – Nationale Carville Star Chairman. Ever since visiting Carville Louisiana several years ago, I have been a staunch supporter of this program.

What is Carville Star - do you know?

Unfortunately, many people do not know what the Carville Star program is all about. It is one of the oldest on-going programs of the 40and8. While Carville, Louisiana was once a hospital housing many patients with Hansen's Disease (otherwise known as Leprosy), it currently has no patients, and the property is overseen by the Louisiana National Guard. The main building on the property is the Carville Star Museum, which houses artifacts from the days when there were patients.

The Star is a quarterly magazine disseminating information regarding the research into Hansen's Disease. The 40and8 Voyageurs and Dames have provided all the equipment necessary for the publication and distribution of the magazine as well as over 80% of the funding.

There are several ways to support this program:

Buy a Country - \$ 50.00 will send 12 one-year subscriptions to a specific county of the donor's choice.

Buy a Clinic - \$ 25.00 will send 25 copies to a clinic to provide them with the most up to date information on Hansen's Disease and the treatment of it. A list of clinics is provided in each issue of The Star.

Subscribe to the Star - \$ 2.00 per year.

Buy a pin – Carville Star pins are available from your Voiture and/or Cabane Chairman.

Donate funds to the Museum fund.

An individual is not likely to lend support to a cause, no matter how worthy, if little or nothing is known about it. Reading the Star will keep you informed about the program and become acquainted with the "Facts about HD" which are printed on the back cover of each issue.

I will be happy to send you a copy of the Officers list to you by email address or post office mail. The reason for this is several Dames have been hacked.
- Please read the Standing Rules 2022: Rendezvous Nationale-Green Bay, Wisconsin
- **Changes to number 12**: The Nationale mailing list is strictly used for La Presidente Nationale candidate and Ways and Means Chairman. You request this list from Correspondante Nationale which only includes the La Presidente and La Correspondante of all Locales and Grandes.
- Added number 21: At Rendezvous Nationale all Grande/Locales should bring five (5) gifts for the La Presidente Nationale Luncheon. This will help defray the cost for the sponsoring Cabane hosting Nationale.
- Travel time for our La Presidente Nationale Robbie Garland. Please send your travel requests for Madam Presidente to Cabane Nationale. Plan ahead Dames! You may contact Cabane Nationale for the necessary request form to be sent to you.
- La Presidente's Nationale Homecoming flyer will be sent out in a separate Chatter blast soon.
- Dames you are AWESOME! Thank you to all of you for doing such a great job in lending a hand and for doing a fabulous job on typing up your committee report minutes. Everyone of you transformed our Rendezvous Nationale into a very huge successful week. "God bless" you Dames.

STANDING RULES AS APPROVED AT RENDEZVOUS NATIONALE September 2022

- 1. Proper dress for Rendezvous: Clean, acceptable clothing, excluding shorts and/or haltertops, is permitted.
- 2. There will be absolutely no smoking permitted during any function.
- 3. Berets shall be worn during Rendezvous and/or other official functions. Never wear a beret and sit at a bar or clubroom when consuming intoxicating liquors.
- 4. Ribbons on a beret shall be worn in a uniform manner. The highest current office shall be on top and toward the front of the beret. La Presidente Nationale Passe wears two gold ribbons, one on top and one on the bottom. All other elected and appointed officers and chairman are allowed to wear the color ribbon they are entitled to wear be it Locale, Grande or Nationale. When you are no longer serving the highest current ribbon that ribbon goes to the bottom of all ribbons.

Ribbons are: Gold-Nationale officer or chairman; White-Grande officer or chairman; Red-Locale officer or chairman; and Blue-Membership.

- 5. Ornaments on all berets shall be kept to a minimum.
- 6. No ornaments or pins are permitted on the ribbons of the beret, except the Official Beret "F" pin.
- 7. All Premier La Grande Presidente shall retain the white ribbon on top as if holding a current Grande office.
- 8. La Garde de La Porte must request the password and current dues card before a Dame is admitted to Rendezvous and/or Cheminot at Nationale, Grande or Locale levels.
- 9. Right-hand salute (hand over the heart) is used when approaching the podium, saluting first the flag and then La Presidente. When leaving the podium right-hand salute the La Presidente and then the flag. Never work across the table between the Colors and Banner.
- 10. Voyageurs are not allowed to attend a Rendezvous. They may bring greetings and/or ask for help for their programs but will be dismissed before La Presidente Nationale continues with Rendezvous business.
- 11. There shall be no selling of trinkets or chances or other articles, or distributing of campaign materials inside Rendezvous Nationale or Cheminot meeting and no closer than fifteen (15) feet from the entrances of the said meeting hall. Only candidates running for offices at the site of Rendezvous Nationale are allowed to campaign from arrival to and including adjournment from said site.
- 12. The Nationale mailing list is strictly used for La Presidente Nationale candidate and Ways and Means Chairman. You request this list from Correspondante Nationale which only includes the La Presidente and La Correspondante of all Locales and Grandes.

- 13. Any Locale or Grande Cabane inviting a Nationale Officer to any function shall be responsible for the Nationale Officers expenses while she is their guest. Transportation is not included.
- 14. All invitations to La Presidente Nationale, any member of her staff, or La Presidente Nationale Passe shall be written in duplicate. The original is sent to the invited person and the duplicate to La Correspondante Nationale who will, in turn, advise the Locale or Grande if the Officer is available to attend.
- 15. Any Dame accepting any Nationale Office must function for her term of office or said Dame will be stripped of her gold ribbon and her title and her name removed from Cabane Nationale's officers list.
- 16. When a resolution for Constitutional changes is sent from a Grande Cabane to various other Grande Cabanes for approval and attesting, the resolution should be sent from the Grande Cabane back to Cabane Nationale with copies sent to the originator.
- 17. There will be no campaigning by candidates for a Nationale office at the Homecoming of a Presidente Nationale.
- 18. Tattoos: If a Dame wishes to use the La Femmes logo for a tattoo, the tattoo may only be placed on the arm or lower leg below the knee.
- 19. If a local Voiture disbands their Cabane can still function but they must still have their program forms signed by a neighboring Voiture and work the Voiture programs.
- 20. No Audio or Video recordings are allowed during any Locale, Grande or Nationale Rendezvous or Cheminot and members should not post anything on Social Media that would reflect poorly on La Societe de Femme.
- 21. At Rendezvous Nationale all Grande/Locales should bring five (5) gifts for the La Presidente Nationale Luncheon. This will help defray the cost for the sponsoring Cabane hosting Nationale.
