The National Youth Sports Program has funds available to help assist the young athletes in your area.. Your Grand can be reimbursed up



to \$1,000.00 for your participation. You select the athlete or athletes that you wish to help. Make your contribution to the athlete or team and then submit the proper claim

form and proof of your contribution to the Directeur Youth Sports. The form requires the signatures of the Locale Directeur, the Grand Directeur and the Nationale Directeur. All payments will be made to the Voiture Locale. There is currently a \$1,000.00 limit per Grand per year. Voiture limits are \$200.00 but can be up to the full amount if only one Voiture in a Grand seeks funding.

Consideration will be given to those Voitures that are involved with a special event that may require funds in excess of the \$200.00. If you think your Voiture, either Locale or Grande, is involved in such a program, please contact the National Directeur. Grand Directors will insure the Locale is participating in the Program before forwarding the request to Nationale. The time and money spent on the Youth Sports Program and other programs of La Societe are well spent. Each year we help thousands of individuals that might otherwise have been overlooked. Many times, the program we support needs assistance other than money. La Societe is a multi-talented group. Sometimes it is just as important to offer our personal talents in lieu of money. The same is true when you get involved in the Youth Sports Program. While the following program will take monetary donations, our time and personal involvement are just as important.

The mission of the Youth Sports Program of La Societe is to assist athletes, ages 7 to 20, in all amateur sports programs, to promote sportsmanship, citizenship, and to emphasize safety to athletes and coaches alike.

The Youth Sports Program carries out its mission by

- 1. Assisting programs that build comradeship, strengthen participation, and encourage competition among amateur athletes.
- 2. Working with other sports organizations to benefit amateur athletes.
- 3. Recognizing young athletes for leadership, high moral character and sportsmanship.

HISTORY

The Youth Sports Program was established at Promenade Nationale in Orlando, Florida in Sept. 1994. It was decided that La Societe needed to expand the boundaries of the AAU/JO



program to include all youth sports and all athletes. All monies remaining in the AAU/JO account were transferred to the Youth Sports Program. The Youth Sports Program was placed under the auspices of the Child Welfare program and we were in business .

During the first year, the Youth Sports committee awarded over \$1,600.00 in grants to Voitures throughout La Societe. The types of programs assisted included girls softball, both boys and girls basketball, American Legion baseball, ice hockey, track and field events, wrestling, Special Olympics, swimming, soccer, cheerleading and competitive dance to name a few. At promenade Nationale in Niagara Falls, NY in Sept 1995, the Youth Sports split from Child Welfare to become a separate and official program of La Societe. At the time, the following positions were established:

- 1 Nationale Directeur Youth Sports
- 1 Nationale Secretary/Treasurer Youth Sports
- 4 Nationale Sous Directeurs Youth Sports

The National Youth Sports Committeee encourage all Voyageurs to get involved in the Youth Sports Programs in their Communities and Grandes!

GENERAL INFORMATION

The National Youth Sports Committee is responsible for contacting each Grande Voiture and promoting the National Youth Sports Program. This is accomplished by providing every Grande Voiture with up to date information concerning the program, providing guidance when applying for grants, soliciting Voyageur ideas and suggestions in the Youth Sports Program.

Every Grande Voiture, and Voiture Locale, is encouraged to participate in this program. This is by nature a high visibility program for La Societe. For this reason, each Grande Voiture, and every Voiture Locale, is asked to have a Youth Sports Directeur. This gives the national Youth Sports Committee, a contact person.

Voitures are encouraged to get involved at the local level. They can assist by helping a team or an individual. They determine the amount of local money used to support the young athletes in their area. They determine the amount of assistance needed, large or small.
